

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- All activities will take place “rain or shine” except during severe weather.
- The Friday evening Cèilidh (Party) gates open at 6:00 PM. Live music starts at 7:00 PM. You must be 21 or older to enter on Friday. Enter from 5th Street!
- The Saturday festival gates open at 9:00 a.m. Admission is only \$10 for everyone 13 & over. Enter from Columbia Avenue! Children 12 and under are free on Saturday.
- Please print your ticket and bring it with you or have the email confirmation ready for scanning on your mobile device. All tickets will be scanned.
- Feel free to bring a camp or “bag” chair to set up to watch music, dance, or the Highland Games on Saturday. An umbrella may be handy for rain or sun!
- We love your pets, too... but, please, registered service animals only.
- No coolers, flasks, etc. Our Michigan liquor license is on the line!
- Keep your wrist band on throughout the event.
- There is no “on-site parking”. There is a 100+ vehicle city parking ramp on 7th Street just two short blocks south of our festival, lots of on-street parking downtown, and we have secured the empty lot at 111 Central Avenue (between 4th and 5th Street). Be patient, keep looking... You will find a spot with just a short walk!
- Those with mobility issues may be dropped off at the north end of Columbia Avenue, in the circular drop off area. No parking in the drop-off area.
- Please use recycling and compost bins whenever possible
